



RCST COVID-19 response activities, Tajikistan



RCST at the forefront of national COVID-19 response:

- Mobilized 2100 volunteers across the country
- Reached 1.3 million people with prevention messages, including a half million schoolchildren
- Reached out to geographically and socially isolated communities, people at risk - remote areas, prisons, people with pre-existing conditions, people affected by TB, PLHIV
- Provided logistic support to MOHSP in delivering essential COVID-19 supplies to rural and city health facilities

Achieved results

During the period March-June, training was conducted among 1,322,452 population in the pilot districts.

On June 6, a joint project of RCST and UN-Women was launched to prevent domestic violence in conditions of quarantine and self-isolation.

100 volunteers of the USAID-funded ETICA project ("Eliminating Tuberculosis in Central Asia") provide food and psychological support to 53 MDR-TB patients in 5 districts of Sughd region and conduct trainings for their families on COVID-19 prevention.

Achieved results

Disinfection of social facilities in Dushanbe

Conducting COVID-19 training sessions in prisons.

Information campaigns in cooperation with the Ministry of Health and the Office of the Traffic Police.

In cooperation with UNICEF, RCST is responsible for the storage and delivery of humanitarian aid from the EU to the district government health structures

With the support of the Kuwait Red Crescent, 1,000 hygiene kits were purchased for 11 public COVID-19 clinics in Dushanbe and Aini region

With the support of the Turkish RC, 30,000 disposable masks were handed over to the Ministry of Health

Achieved results

1,100 orphans in Dushanbe and districts of Khatlon region receive a monthly cash allowance

2,000 families of the Sughd region from among vulnerable groups received cash benefits

Support for 16 quarantine zones (hygiene kits)

Food parcels for 800 people
